

With the passage of Proposal 3 in November 2018, all Michigan voters are now eligible to receive an absentee ballot without needing to provide a reason.

Any registered voter may request, orally or in writing, to be placed on the <u>Permanent Absent Voter List</u>. Those on the list will automatically be sent an absentee ballot application for each election. This application will need to be completed and returned in order to receive a ballot.

A request to be placed on the <u>Permanent Absent Voter List</u> may be made by calling Robinson Township Hall at (616) 846-2210 or by completing the bottom portion of this notice and returning it to Robinson Township.

Voters on the Permanent Absentee List do not have to vote by mail. If you would prefer to vote in person for any particular election, do not complete the absentee ballot application you received in the mail. Instead, simply vote (in person) at your precinct between the hours of 7am and 8pm on Election Day. Note: Voting in person will not remove your name from the Permanent Absentee List. However, you may remove your name (at any time) from the list by contacting Robinson Township.
