Hayward made a motion supported by Vugteveen to approve the transfer of the Clark Farm Class B Earth Change permit from Tacoma Industries, LLC to S&M Gravel, Inc. subject to the same conditions as previously established. Roll call vote was held with all members present voting yes. Motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding ARPA funding.

Discussion was held regarding the possible overage in the tree trimming project on Limberlost. Supervisor Johnson stated he would follow up.

Reports were given. Fire Department ran 336 calls in 2021.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Bergman to pay the bills. Motion carried.
