

Minutes of the Regular Meeting

Present: Supervisor Frank Johnson, Treasurer Bonnie Hayward, Clerk Christine Saddler, Trustee Travis Vugteveen and Trustee Travis Bergman

The meeting was opened at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Supervisor Johnson gave the invocation

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Hayward to approve the minutes of the October 12, 2022 Regular Board Meeting. Motion carried.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Bergman to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Supervisor Johnson gave his opening remarks.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Hayward to approve the renewal of the Class B Earth Change Permit for Emerald Lake with the same motion as approved by the Planning Commission at their meeting on October 25, 2022. Roll call vote was held with all members present voting yes. Motion carried.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Bergman to approve the framework for brining of the roads in 2023 to be a 1650 gallons per mile 16 to 24 ft wide application done in May, June, July and August. Motion carried.

Saddler made a motion supported by Bergman to approve the renewal of the Provident Accident & Health Policy for the Fire Department selecting the present plan: 3 year prepaid premium option at a cost of \$10,625. Roll call vote was held with all members present voting yes. Motion carried.

Public comment: Matt Pohl questioned the requirements for private road/driveway access for a property on 124th Ave. the Zoning Administrator will be instructed to follow up with Attorney Bultje for any clarification.

Rich Anderson questioned the possibility of requesting a ZBA variance for a required minimum distance between buildings. He was informed that the PC was reviewing a possible change and the ZBA meeting may not be necessary if he waits for the PC.

Fire Chief VanVelzen suggested a payment to firefighters for COVID. He was reminded that he had previously implemented a program during COVID.

Hayward made a motion supported by Vugteveen to approve Local Government Approval Resolution 2022-11-16 for granting approval for Pigeon Creek Golf Course to apply for a Class C Liquor License upon Zoning Approval of the project. Roll call vote was held with all members present voting yes. Motion carried.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Bergman to pay the bills. Motion carried.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Bergman to adjourn the meeting at 8:47 pm. Motion carried.
