The meeting was called to order at 6:32 p.m.

Berens gave an invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Hayward made a motion supported by Vugteveen to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

JD Schamper, 12155 Johnson Street, Grand Haven who is the Treasurer of Roadrunners United, the Robinson Elementary School's PTO organization said that the State gaming authority requires that organizations must be recognized as a nonprofit operating in the Township before a license will be granted. Hayward made a motion supported by Vugteveen to pass Resolution # 2018-03-09 Local Governing Body Resolution for Charitable Gaming Licenses recognizing Roadrunners United. Roll call vote was held with all members voting yes. Motion carried.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Berens to accept the bid from Zeeland Blacktop for the repaving of the Fire Department parking lot in the amount of \$43,500. Roll call vote was held with all members voting yes. Motion carried.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Berens to table the discussion on brush removal in the park pending more details on scope of project and confirmation that wood chips would remain on site. Motion carried.

Kuck made a motion supported by Vugteveen to table the discussion on playground equipment. Motion carried.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Kuck to table the discussion on installation of a split rail fence in the park on the North side until more information can be gathered. Motion carried.

Hayward made a motion supported by Saddler to have maintenance take down the horse shed in the park after a review of work needed is completed. Motion carried.

Berens made a motion supported by Hayward to untable the Young Bucs storage pod discussion. Motion carried.

Kuck made a motion supported by Hayward to allow placement of a storage pod by Young Bucs for storage of their golf cart at their cost with location to be determined by the Township after proof of insurance coverage for loss is provided by the Young Bucs. Motion carried.
