Berens made a motion to approve resolution # 2014-08-23. Hayward supported the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all members voting aye. The motion carried.

Hayward made a motion to set up an assigned account for needed maintenance, repairs and improvements to the Township Hall and grounds. This would set aside 10% of the year end excess of revenues over expenditures beginning 04/01/15. Frye seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken and all members voted aye. The motion was approved.

Berens made a motion to approve payment of the \$22.00 over run cost of a new camera. Hayward supported the motion and it was approved.

Vugteveen made a motion to approve the hiring of Eric Bailey, Brad Brower, and Jerry Westerman as fire fighters for the Fire Department. Hayward supported the motion and it was approved.

Vugteveen made a motion to agree with the Planning Commission's decision to ~~proceed with~~ consider a moratorium for the sub-area of M-231. Berens supported the motion and it was approved.

There was a discussion on a possible non-motorized recreational path in Robinson Township. It was decided to include a survey in the winter tax bills to judge the interest of the public.

Berens made a motion to pay the bills. Vugteveen supported the motion and it was approved.
