The Meeting was opened by Supervisor Mulligan, She expressed the Townships gratitude to Josh Kleinheskel. For a Boy Scout Project he did a beautiful job on the mile markers for the Park.

Berens made a motion to approve the October 2014 minutes. Hayward supported the motion and it was approved.

Hayward made a motion to approve the agenda. Berens supported the motion and it was approved.

Commissioner DeJong gave a summary of several local and state issues. He also answered questions from the audience.

Hayward made a motion to table agenda item # 1 until more information was made available. Berens supported the motion and it carried.

Frye made a motion to accept Kurt Koella's resignation from the Water Board due to a conflict of interest. Berens seconded the motion and it was approved.

The various issues concerning public water in areas of Robinson Township were discussed.

Berens made a motion to approve Budget Amendment Resolution #2014-12-28. Increasing the cemetery budget by \$3,000.00 and the Public Works Dept. by \$3,000.00. Reducing the Clerk's dept. budget by \$3,000.00 and reducing the Township Board dept. by \$3,000.00 Frye supported the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all members voting aye. The resolution was approved.

Aerial and explosives fireworks were discussed.

Hayward made a motion to accept the Public Record Inspection/Examination Policy. Berens supported the motion and it was approved.

Hayward made a motion to approve resolution # 2014-12-27. To impose a moratorium on the issuance of permits or licenses for medical marihuana centers within the Township of Robinson. Berens seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. All members voted aye. The motion carried.

Chief VanVelzen reported that our ISO rating has risen from 8-10 to 7-10. This may save as much \$50.00 to \$60.00 on a yearly house insurance bill.

Hayward made a motion to pay the bills. Berens seconded it. The motion carried.

Frye made a motion to adjourn. Hayward supported the motion and the meeting adjourned at 8:37 pm.
