FRYE MADE A MOTION TO MOVE AHEAD WITH THE GYPSY MOTH SUPPRESSION PROGRAM FOR 2010. THIS WILL COVER 500 ACRES IN ROBINSON TOWNSHIP THAT ARE INFESTED. HAYWARD SUPPORTED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION CARRIED.

A POSSIBLE GRANT OF LICENSE WAS DISCUSSED FOR WEST MICHIGAN WARRIORS BASEBALL CLUB. SUPERVISOR MULLIGAN WILL BE CHECKING FOR ANY CONFLICT OF ISSUES.

BERENS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE SOLICITOR REGULATION ORDINANCE # 2010-01-01. FRYE SUPPORTED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION WAS APPROVED.

SUPERVISOR MULLIGAN GAVE AN UPDATE ON THE RESULTS OF A MEETING SHE ATTENDED CONCERNING THE BEAR CREEK DRAIN.

DISCUSSIONS WERE HELD ON WATER ISSUES WITH ALLENDALE CONCERNING 96TH AVE.

THE MAINTENANCE POSITION WAS DISCUSSED. IT WAS DECIDED THAT BIDS WOULD BE PUT OUT FOR PARK MOWING AND STRIPING AND INTERVIEWS OF CANDIDATES FOR THE MAINTENANCE POSITION WOULD BE HELD AFTER FEBRUARY.

PAUL VANVELZEN WAS GIVEN PERMISSION BY THE BOARD TO INSTALL SHELVING FOR ELECTION SUPPLIES IN THE SMALL GARAGE/WORKSHOP.

FRYE MADE A MOTION TO REDUCE THE BUDGET FOR ELECTIONS BY \$1500.00 AND TO INCREASE THE BUDGET FOR CIVIL DEFENSE BY \$1500.00. ALSO TO REDUCE THE INSPECTION DEPARTMENT BUDGET BY \$5000.00 AND TO INCREASE THE PUBLIC WORKS BUDGET BY \$5000.00. KUYERS SECONDED THE MOTION. A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN. AYES: KUYER, MULLIGAN, BERENS, HAYWARD AND FRYE. NAYS: NONE. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED.
