

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE
ROBINSON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
HELD 11/15/2010 AT 7:30 P.M.**

THE MEETING WAS OPENED WITH AN INVOCATION FOLLOWED BY THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

HAYWARD MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE OCTOBER MINUTES WITH ONE CHANGE: TO ADD THE WORD PAVING TO THE MOTION TO SET UP A ROAD MAINTENANCE ACCOUNT. KUYERS SUPPORTED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION CARRIED.

KUYERS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA. BERENS SUPPORTED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION CARRIED.

A DISCUSSION WAS HELD ON THE METRO ACT. NO ACTION BY THE BOARD WAS NEEDED AT THIS TIME.

FRYE MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE RESOLUTION # 2010-11-21 THE FORECLOSURE SALE RESOLUTION IN REGARD TO PARCEL #70-08-16-400-46. BERENS SUPPORTED THE MOTION. A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN. AYES: KUYERS, MULLIGAN, BERENS, HAYWARD AND FRYE. NAYS: NONE. THE RESOLUTION WAS APPROVED.

BERENS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE A BUDGET TRANSFER AMENDMENT TO TRANSFER \$13211.28 FROM THE ROAD BRINING BUDGET TO THE DRAIN ACCOUNT. THIS IS TO COVER DRAIN ASSESSMENTS CHARGED TO ROBINSON TOWNSHIP. KUYERS SUPPORTED THE MOTION AND THERE WAS A ROLL CALL VOTE. AYES: HAYWARD, FRYE, BERENS, KUYERS AND MULLIGAN. THE BUDGET TRANSFER WAS APPROVED.

THE INCREASE IN THE POSTAL MACHINE RENTAL WAS DISCUSSED. THE SUPERVISOR WAS ASKED TO CHECK INTO THE LEASE BEFORE A DECISION IS MADE.

HAYWARD EXPLAINED THE ROBINSON TOWNSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR THE COUNTY'S PRE-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AND ASKED TO ENLIST CHRIS SADDLER IN COMPLETING THE PROJECT. EVERYONE AGREED THAT THE HELP WAS NEEDED.

A CHANGE IN ASSESSOR'S DAYS AT THE TOWNSHIP WERE DISCUSSED HE WILL NOW BE IN ON MONDAY AND TUESDAY INSTEAD OF MONDAY AND THURSDAY.

THE RESOLUTION FOR A MEDICAL MARIHUANA MORATORIUM WAS READ. BERENS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE. HAYWARD SUPPORTED THE MOTION AND A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN. AYES: FRYE, BERENS, HAYWARD, MULLIGAN, AND KUYERS. NAYS: NONE.

DISCUSSIONS WERE HELD ON THE MONTHLY INCREASE IN THE SECURITY PROTECTION PROGRAM, IN HOUSE INSPECTIONS, A MEETING IN ALLENDALE, THE INT. PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE, WORK FOR A VOLUNTEER DOING COMMUNITY SERVICE, THE REQUEST BY A RESIDENT TO REINSTATE THE ANNUAL MEETING, THE ENERGY AUDIT AND GRANT AND PERMITS APPLIED FOR BY THOSE THAT HAVE A LIABILITY TO THE TOWNSHIP.

HAYWARD EXPLAINED THE CHANGES TO PURCHASING DOG LICENSE SET FORTH BY OTTAWA COUNTY. SOME VETERINARIANS WILL BE SELLING LICENSES IN THEIR OFFICES. THEY MAY STILL BE PURCHASED AT THE TOWNSHIP OR COUNTY. THERE WILL BE A CHOICE BETWEEN A 1 YEAR LICENSE AND A THREE YEAR LICENSE. THE CURRENT 2010 DOG LICENSE WILL EXPIRE IN THE MONTH THAT THE RABIES VACCINATION EXPIRES. A MAILING WILL BE SENT TO REMIND YOU IN THE MONTH OF THE EXPIRATION. IF NOT PURCHASED IN THAT MONTH A DELINQUENT FEE WILL BE ADDED TO THE COST OF THE LICENSE.

KUYERS MADE A MOTION TO PAY THE BILLS. BERENS SUPPORTED THE MOTION. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED.
