The Board approved the meeting agenda with a motion by Frye that was seconded by Hayward.

Berens made a motion seconded by Vugteveen to approve the previous month's meeting minutes. The motion carried.

Berens made a motion to table the Clark Farm surety bond issue until our Oct. meeting. Frye supported the motion and it was approved.

Hayward made a motion to pass resolution 2013-09-12 a Performance Resolution for MDOT. Berens supported the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all members voting aye. The resolution passed.

Vugteveen made a motion to increase the Class A Earth Change Application Escrow to a minimum of \$300.00. Berens seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken. All members voted aye. The motion carried.

Vugteveen made a motion to opt for the jetty option over the retention basin for the road project drainage issue. Hayward supported the motion and it was approved.

Berens made a motion to approve the Sokolow class A pond application with the added requirements of the P.C.

1. Compliance with the application.

3. Compliance with the Lakeshore Environmental report.
4. A lot merger agreement acceptable to the Township Attorney.
5. Compliance with the verbal representations in the Planning Commission minutes.

The motion was seconded by Vugteveen. The motion carried.

Hayward made a motion to have a split rail fence installed at the Park not to exceed \$5000.00 in cost. Berens supported the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all members voting aye. The motion was approved.
