THIS IS BECAUSE OF THE EXTRA HOURS THEY WORKED ON ELECTION DAY.

KUYERS MADE A MOTION TO PAY A ONE-TIME PRINCIPAL PAYMENT OF \$67,000.00 TO ALLENDALE CHARTER TOWNSHIP FOR OUR WATER DEBT. FRYE SUPPORTED THE MOTION. A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN. YEAS: BERENS, HAYWARD, FRYE, KUYERS AND MULLIGAN. NAYS: NONE. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED.
